#### Emergencies

First Aid - BC Place has first aid on site during all events

- □ First aid is located at Sec. 132 during all operating hours
- Contact first aid at 604-661-7249
- Please ensure you note your exact location, then call Security at 604-661-3604 after calling first aid
- □ For medical emergencies please call **911** and then call first aid and advise them 911 has been called

## Evacuations

- Emergency Exits: An evacuation will be called on the Public Address System with a tone signal in between the announcement. Please listen carefully. BC Place will lead the evacuation. Review your areas when you are working to note the nearest safe exit as marked throughout the facility
- Muster Point Proceed to the muster station location at the base of the large outdoor video board outside the East Entrance; remain there until your attendance has been taken

## **Bomb Threats**

- Do not touch or move suspicious packages
- □ Notify security in-person, not with a radio or cell phone

## Hazards, Policies, Procedures, and Practices

## **Control Zones & Restricted Areas**

- □ <u>Danger tape</u> and/or red rope = no entry
- □ <u>Caution tape</u> = be aware of work activities in the area
- Duty Mangers approval required to enter restricted areas

#### Safety and Personnel Protection at BC Place

All employees and volunteers are required to ensure they are familiar with which safety equipment is required under Work Safe BC for the type of work they are performing. This includes:

- Safety Footwear
- □ High Visibility Vests (\$8.50 + GST) each at Exhibitor Services)
- □ Hard Hats when overhead work is being performed
- Fall Protection when working 10 feet or more above grade.
   A specific fall protection plan for the work being undertaken will also be required to be submitted prior to the work commencing.

## **General Safety Requirements at BC Place**

- Absolutely no children under the age of 16 are permitted on the floor during move in/out.
- Absolutely no animals are permitted on the floor during move in/out.
- Report unsafe conditions and equipment to a BC Place Duty Manager immediately
- Do not enter a job site with an impaired ability to work. The use of alcohol and/or drugs are strictly forbidden on the job
- Arrange storage and work areas to allow safe movement of fork lifts, equipment, and materials.
- □ Keep floor clear of oil, grease, and other materials which create slipping hazards
- Identify, store, and handle hazardous materials in accordance with WHMIS regulations. Flammable materials must not be stored near buildings
- Only BC Place staff may perform electrical work of any kind or enter electrical rooms
- Bicycles are not allowed to be operated within the stadium
- Scaffolding must be assembled as per WCB regulations and /or the manufacturer's instructions.

## Pedestrian and Vehicular Traffic Hazards

- Use the <u>vellow painted pedestrian walkway</u> when walking on the Level 1 concourse
- High visibility vests are to be worn at all times except from 3 hours before an event start time until the general public has left the facility

Parking is available adjacent to BC Place. Additional lots are located across Expo Blvd. at Costco and across Pacific Blvd. at the Edgewater Casino/Plaza of Nations.
